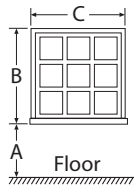


Here are step-by-step instructions to measure you kitchen properly. Requirements are: tape measure, paper and pencil.
Accuracy in the measuring procedure are the key elements so make sure you double check all measurements.

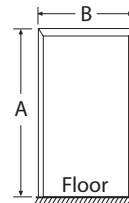
- 1 a) Begin in any corner of the room with tape measure at waist height, and measure to an adjacent wall. Always measure in inches only, not feet and inches!
b) Record your first measurement and continue around the room measuring all walls where cabinetry will be installed.
c) Once completed, draw the floor plan and add your measurements.
- 2 a) Measure all doors, windows and wall openings. Any door trim, window trim or opening trim is considered part of the opening, and should be recorded.
c) Record your measurements (in inches only) on the charts provided below for reference in the next step.

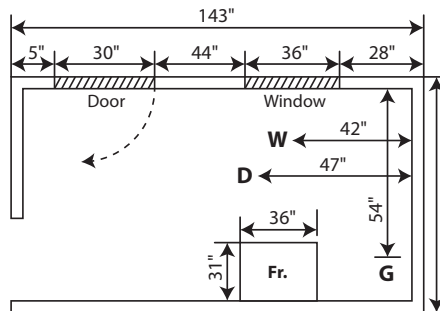

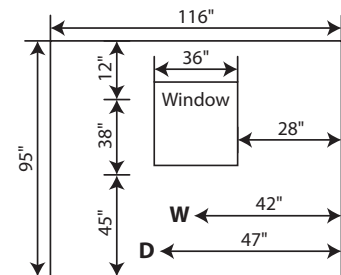
- 3 Locate all openings on your floor plan. Measure from the wall corner to outside edge of opening trim and locate it on drawing. Add opening dimension and then, measure from outside edge of trim to adjacent wall. Repeat process for all openings. Identify all openings then label wall numbers for future elevation drawing reference. When placing doors on drawing, be sure to indicate which way the door opens (Example 1, Floor Plan)

- 4 Draw an elevation of each wall and locate all openings. Be sure to include the ceiling height and show soffits (boxed build-down from ceiling), if you have them or plan on adding them. For easy identification, use the symbols shown below to locate water lines, drain lines and gas lines. Check out (Example 2, Elevation).

W - Water Lines
D - Drain Lines
G - Gas Lines
